CHESTNUT PATH

Evisa () 2h there and back



Start to the village of Evisa to discover the Chestnut grove and its history through pictorials signs. A beautiful hike, well signposted with many explanatory signs. Between the wild pigs, the hollow paths, the dry stone walls, the hundred-year-old chestnuts and finally the natural pools you will be delighted. Presence of didactic panels, stone walls, «ghjostru», statues carved in chestnut wood.

AITONE WATERFALLS



9 Evisa 0 30min there and back

If you want to continue your walk, you can reach the natural pools of Aïtone. At the end of the path of the chestnut trees, you will arrive on the D84. Pass it and continue on a slight descent. From there, the pools will be about 10 minutes walk.

GORGES DE LA SPELUNCA

Par evisa \(\Quad \) 4h00 a/r

Departure from the D84 road. After the cemetery, 500 m of elevation gain. Old mule track that linked Ota to Evisa. Halfway there is the Genoese bridge of Zaglia. Another shorter possibility from the Two Bridges in Ota to the Zaglia bridge to access the bottom of the gorges in 1h30.

REVINDA - E CASE

Marignana () 2h there and back

Direction Piana turn 7km to the sign Revinda and follow the road to the hamlet. The pedestal path starts to the right of the church. On this way, continue to the cottage «E CASE» (a sign indicates the direction).

REMOTE VILLAGE OF MUNA

Murzo Visite 40min a/r

Follow the road Sagone-Vico-Murzo and direction Rosazia. Half way at the mailbox, there is a possibility to park. A path leads to the remote but restored village offering a beautiful panorama.

CRENO LAKE

Soccia () 3h there and back

Take the D70 until Vico then D23 until Soccia. Follow the road above the village who goes to the parking. The trail starts at the parking and following the river on the north slope of Monte Sant Eliseo.

BONUS RADULE WATERFALLS Albertacce



• 2h00 there and back

Departure after the pass of Vergio, D84 towards Albertaccia, a big bend called «the horseshoe». Follow the GR20 to the sheepfold then the waterfalls.



MOUNT CASTELLU OF CINARCA

© Calcatoggio U 1h there and back

Take the junction at Liscia/Masorchia (D601), go straight up until the end of the coated and the beginning of the dirt track. Leave the vehicle and start walking along the trail. 5 minutes later, on the left at the level of an electric pole with a blue label, begins the hiking trail that will lead to the summit. From the top you will enjoy the view overlooking the Gulf of Sagone, Tiuccia and the Genoese towers of Capigliolu as well as the whole valley of Cinarca.

CAPIGLIOLU TOWER



From the D81 road north of the Golf of Liscia, just after the fire station of Casaglione. After having parked the car at the entrance of Tiuccia on a solid land, the trail starts due north. The trail allows to discover the fort and the Genoese tower of Capigliolu with a splendid view on the beach of Liamone, but also on the Gulf of Liscia.

MONTE LAZZU

Casaglione () 2h there and back

From Tiuccia, take the D25 from the D81 after the big bend at the end of the village. Continue for about 1.6km. Go to the place called «Colonna», park on the right on a small area marked by two tourists signs.

OMIGNA TOWER



From the beach of Peru, above «Ta Kladia», keep on the path until the tower.



POINTE DU TRIU

Sagone () 1h30 circle

From Sagone (D81), parking of the pointe of Triu, indicated by a Coastal Conservatory's sign. At the start of the way, a few small steps then slight climb without difficulty, almost the whole loop is done in flat ground.

PUNTIGLIONE

From center of Cargèse, follow the main road to going to the Port. In the big bend overlooking a sea view, a sign on the right indicates the start.

CAPO ROSSO Difficult



Piana () 3h30 there and back

From Piana (D824) towards the beach of Arone for about 6km, a sign indicates the departure. Cappu Rossu is one of the highest sea cliffs in Europe. A beautiful hike allows you to discover the coast of Capo Rosso up to the top of the Genoese tower overlooking the cape.

MULE TRACK



Piana U 1h30 there and back

From the Municipal Stadium, cross the stage, take the wooden bridge and take the track that climb to the left.

GIROLATA

Osani 3 3h30 there and back

From Col de la croix (D81), follow the sign and the orange markings to descend to the beach of Tuara. Cross the latter, at the bottom of the beach take the left path sign «chemin du facteur». The path goes up a little steep and evolves in balcony above the coast, to go down again on Girolata.
