STORIA NOVA per a Restonica

At the start of the 2024 season, a new era is opening for the classified site of Restonica following the havoc that was caused by the Ciaran and Domingos tempests in November 2023 (*) Corte commune and its partners have joined their efforts to rethink the valley mobility and make you (re) discover the unique beauty of this emblematic site of Corsica natural heritage. In this guide, you will find more than 30km of open hiking trails of all levels in Restonica. You will also find a new way to access those trails, thanks to the seasonal shuttle "Restonica" put in place for the first time by the Territorial Collectivity of Corsica.

* A part of the road that leads to the higher part of the valley was taken away, the access by all types of vehicles is impossible. The use of the shuttle is therefore strongly recommended for your visit of the

NEW - SHUTTLE UN NOVU SERVIZIU: A NAVETTA

A seasonal collective transport by shuttles, is organized by the Territorial Collectivity of Corsica and will run 7/7 from May 2nd to September 28th. Those shuttles will leave from Corte train station allowing you to access to the hiking trails and the departure points situated in Restonica.

HOTELS AND CAMPINGS ACCEDDIBILITY ACCESSIBILITÀ ALBERGHI È CAMPEGHJI

Hotels and Campings located in the Valley between Corte and Tuani stay accessible to motorized vehicles. Passed Tuani, the traffic of motorized vehicles (except shuttle, beneficiaries, and bike) is forbidden.

THE LOWER part of the valley U chjassu di Zurmulu

CORTE - PUNTA DI ZURMULU - GHJARASGIOLU FOOTBRIDGE

The first part of this hike, which is shaded, takes you up to the Punta di Zurmulu from Corte. This small summit is a balcony overlooking the town, the citadel and the two valleys. On a clear day, you can even see the sea in the background! The second part takes you to the Chjarasgiolu footbridge in Restonica valley.


















Water self-sufficiency









- At the U Tavignanu gite sign, turn right.
- Take the path in the shade of the oaks on the left, that goes along a property isolated by a wall.
- Now the path leads to an uncovered slope, then in the shade of the pines to the pass.
 - ► Then head to the left for an easy climb to the summit.
 - The summit of Punta di Zurmulu offers a superb view over the town of Corte and the surrounding area.
- Climb back down to the pass, then begin the descent towards Restonica valley.

From here, there are two ways to reach Corte: Return with the shuttle or on foot to Corte (+45 min) Continue the hike from San Teofalu (+ 2h35)

CORTE - PUNTA DI U CORBU - GHJARASGIOLU FOOTBRIDGE

A beautiful hike, leaving from the Chapel Saint Antoine of Corte, offers nice point of view of the city and its surroundings.




Departure at the foot of the Chapel Saint Antoine of Corte.

- After a little slope, go to the right. A few meters away on your left is an orange marked trail.
- The trail goes up to the foot of the Punta di U Corbu.
- Do not take the trail on the left. You reach a little pass. Follow up straight ahead to go to Restonica. Now follow the yellow marks.
- Source of the Persighellu.
- The trail continues in the shades of the pines.





Return to Corte available by shuttle + Add 45min if your return on foot to Corte.

THE LOWER part of the valley Uchjassu di u fiume

GHJARASGIOLU FOOTBRIDGE - TUANI - RIVISECCU

Shaded trail, punctuated by bathing in clear waters of Restonica, ideal for a family walk. The "Easy" way: take the shuttle to Riviseccu and do the hike downhill.

Departure from Ghjarasgiolu available by

- This itinerary can be split into 2 parts:
- from the footbridge of Ghjarasgiolu to
- from Tuani to the footbridge of Riviseccu Take the trail on the right when off the footbridge of Chjarasgiolu.
- Arrival at the Tuani Camping, cross it.



From Tuani, two possibilities are available:

- follow up to the left, take the trail that allows you to reach the footbridge Riviseccu (1h30 walk)
- return to Corte by shuttle



From the Riviseccu Bridge, reach the road for the return to Corte available by shuttle.



THE MID-valley U chjassu di a muntagnera

TUANI - A FORCA DI A LANCIA - CAPPELLACCIA SHEEPFOLDS

A hiking alternative of the Cappellaccia sheepfolds that offer a spectacular panorama of the island mountains: Ritondu, Lombarducciu, Paglia Orba, Cintu.








Departure and return: Tuani available by

- Trail on the right, on top of the fence on the road. Traced on an old path that runs along the southern slopes of Restonica.
- Arrival at the ridges, take the trail on the left.
 - Follow the line on the ridges toward Forcelle.
 - You reach a small summit named Forcelle. The panorama is breathtaking.

THE MID-valley U chjassu di u Finellu

TUANI - A FORCA DI A LANCIA - PUNTA DI ZURMULU - CORTE

A sportive hike that, by the ridges, allows you to follow the line of water divide between the Restonica river and the Tavignanu river, by the Punta di u Finellu, to the Zurmulu summit overlooking the city of Corte.



Departure from Tuani available by shuttle.

- Take the trail on the right for Corte. To the left the trail goes to Cappellaccia sheepfolds.
- Then the trail goes to the foot of the Punta di u Finellu.
- Arrival at the end of the Ridges, by a climb quite easy, you reach the summit of Zurmulu.
- While going down the little summit, retrace your steps on few meters at the level of the pass to take the trail that goes down to the pines, toward Tavignanu Valley, and reach Corte.

THE HIGH plateau U chjassu di Alzu

A FRASSETA - CAPPELLACCIA SHEEPFOLDS - PLATEAU D'ALZU

A hike, in the footsteps of the shepherds that still practice the transhumance, that offers as a reward a wonderful panorama on the mountains at the heart of Corsica and the opportunity to meet shepherds in the seasonal period.

Departure and Arrival: Frasseta available by

- The trail, marked in red, goes up in a vaw in the pines. Intersection at the sign: take the trail on the right (toward Pianu Alzu).
- Crossing the Funtana Bianca brook. Below the brook you can drink the water source.
- Arrival at the Cappellaccia sheepfolds.
- A sign indicates you the way to the plateau d'Alzu that can be seen below.

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THE UPPER valley U chjassu di E Gruttelle

A FRASSETA - GROTTELLE SHEEPFOLDS

Unique access to the high part of Restonica Valley, this hike will lead you to the famous E Grotelle sheepfolds and, for the more athletics, at the start of the hike toward the lakes.

Take the trail, marked in red, that goes up in a yaw in the pines.

Sign: Intersection to the left path (toward Grotelle).

Cross the brook.

At the Lamaghjosu bridge, there is 2 km left to reach the Grotelle sheepfolds.



Departure and Arrival: Frasseta available by

- Take the trail, marked in red, that goes up in a yaw in the pines.
- → Sign: Intersection to the left path (toward Grotelle).
- Arrival at Grotelle.
- → Take the yellow marked trail toward the Melu
- ➤ Path on the right: passage of ladders
- ➤ Arrival at the Melu Lake (1h15 walk from Grotelle).
- A water source is near the guardian's refuge, walk a bit away from the path to reach it.
- Continue toward Capitellu lake (45 min walk from the Melu lake).


